He had a series of other health related issues previously, as well as heart complications, however this time he was unable to recover. My father was an incredible individual with an extremely kind heart and although he was not around for a section of growing up, Sydney Legacy was. From a young age, Sydney Legacy provided financial assistance in the difficult time after my father's passing to my mother and I, as well as any sort of emotional support that was required. My personal experience arose from meeting other junior legatees at various camps through my teenage years. The bond that I developed with those legatees is just as strong today as it was back then. I believe that having a strong, healthy circle of support is crucial to helping me grow as a person and Legacy has provided me with this. 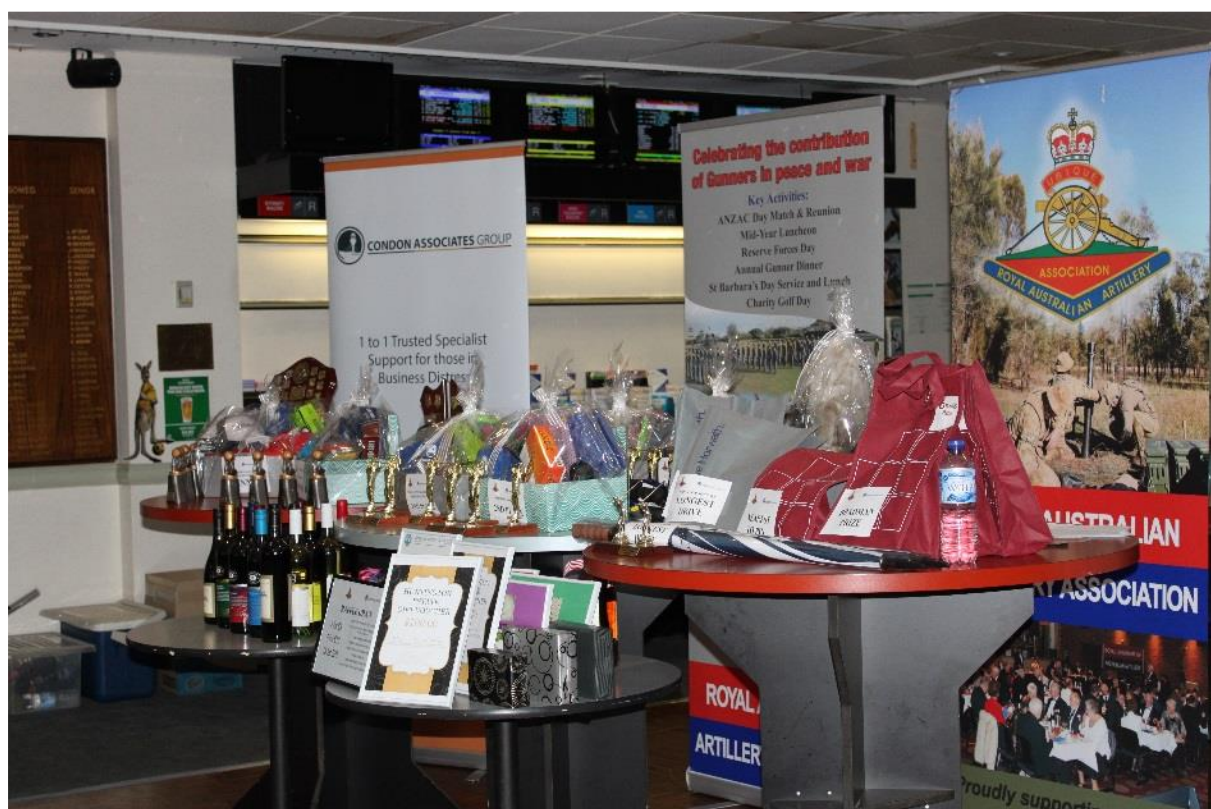

Teams will compete for either the Condon Advisory Corporate Shield or the RAAA Shield in accordance to the rules below:

The Aim

The aim is to have fun, promote Gunner traditions, and raise funds for Legacy.

Teams and Individual Players

Individual players will be allocated into an appropriate team.

Teams competing for the RAAA Shield will be made up of those representing the Army units; Navy units; Air Force units; RAA units; units containing an RAA component e.g. Headquarters, Training Units, Artillery Associations; RSL Sub-branch; Lodge members; serving and ex-serving person(s).

Teams competing for the Condon Advisory Corporate Shield will be any team that does not comply with the above criteria.

Type of Game

Four Ball Ambrose.

Equipment and Other Facilities

Golf equipment is available for hire at the pro-shop at the Club.

Booking and payment needs to be directly arranged with the pro-shop.

In Case of Bad Weather

In case of bad weather or if the Club is closed, players will be notified accordingly, or you can contact the Cumberland Country Golf Club on 02 9631 0688.

Four Ball Ambrose Competition Game Rules

- Teams of up to 4 people.
- A team Captain will be nominated for each team. The Team Captain's word is final within the team.
- An Adjudicator will be nominated for the day, and the Adjudicator's word will be final on all decisions made concerning the day's golf. The Adjudicator's decision overrides the Team Captain's where there is a conflict.
- Individual handicaps must be clearly shown against each player's name. Men's maximum 27, ladies maximum 36.
- Men hit from white markers, ladies hit from the red markers.
- Each player hits off the tee, the best shot is selected by the Team Captain and all other players pick up their ball and place it within one club length of the nominated point.
- Each player's tee shot MUST be selected at least three holes. Player's initials must be indicated on the card against corresponding hole.
- If your best ball is played from within a hazard then each of the player's balls must be played from within that hazard.
- If you are in a team of 3 players (for 4 men Ambrose), fourth putt may be taken by any of the team members.
- The golf club will calculate the final team scores based on handicaps submitted. (Handicaps will be summed and divided by 8 for teams of 4, or divided by 6 for teams of 3)
- If there are two or more teams with the same score, the winner will be decided by a Team Captain's putt off.
- If for any reason play is abandoned, the result will be determined by the Adjudicator and the Club's professional.
- Golf club will pick the holes for: Nearest To Pin, Longest Drive, and Longest Straight Drive.
